Collective Impact! – Preparing for Strategic Planning – *Denise Herbert*

Abstract: 2016 is a Strategic Planning year for the KCPC. The current strategic plan document ends September 30, 2016. The KCPC General Assembly along with other community stakeholders will enter the summer months planning Kent County's SUD Prevention activities for 2017 – 2021.

KCPC Sustainability: Reviewing the Landscape! Ashley Pattee

Abstract: Sustainability is our ability to maintain or support KCPC activities over the long term. It's a method of harvesting or using resources so existing resources are not depleted or permanently damaged.

Phase 1: KCPC Sustainability Planning process was introduced at the November 2015 GA meeting.

<u>Phase 2</u>: The General Assembly prioritized the ideas generated using the 'Keep It, Ditch It, Discuss It' method (January 2016).

Phase 3: The group engaged in a 2-part activity designed to fine tune the official KCPC Action Plan for the next 8, 20 and 32 months.

Phase 4: Mission Possible (MP) Group Presentations; followed by MP Keep it! / Ditch it!

- 1. Profit for Non-Profit Keep it!
- 2. Pursue United Way Keep it!
- 3. Partnerships with Current Campaigns to Share Proceeds Ditch it!
- 4. Connect with Area Breweries for Financial Support Ditch it!
- 5. A NEW combination of #3 and #4 Keep it!

KCPC Committee Re-engagement – Michele Stitt / Denise Herbert

Abstract: The KCPC's ability to be vocal, visible, and valuable in the community depends upon building partnerships, valuing people, harnessing passion, and pursuing a commitment to outcomes that will change lives and improve the health and wellness in Kent County. To that end, the KCPC will form "Groups" convened by the Executive Committee that will focus on the People, Passion, Partnerships, & Performance in order to impact change in Kent County.

After an extensive review of the GA feedback and many discussions following the November 2015, Coalition 201 "Nuts & Bolts" - "Call to Action" interactive activities to help move the work of the Coalition forward. The Executive Committee

has prepared a recommended structure that will engage both formal and informal KCPC community stakeholders. As part of the strategic planning process the launch of the new structure will begin October 1, 2016.
