Family Day 2017 – Family Meals Matter! – Denise Herbert

Abstract: September, 2017 marks Family Meals Month, a national initiative designed to celebrate the positive impact parents can have in leading their children away from engaging in substance use and other risky behavior. Research shows children with parents who are 'hands on' and involved in their day-to-day activities and lives are far less likely to smoke, drink or use drugs. **In 2016**, network180 and the Kent County Prevention Coalition (KCPC), led a special Family Meals Month initiative with Brann's Restaurants. **Through continued conversations**, the KCPC and Brann's are committed to advancing a more targeted promotion on September 25, 2017, as part of Family Meals Month effort.
