MiPHY 2018 Report Summary: Brian Hartl

Abstract: The impact of obtaining and using local data is of utmost importance. MiPHY is an online student survey offered by the Michigan Departments of Education and Health and Human Services to support local and regional needs assessment. The MiPHY provides student results on health risk behaviors including substance use, violence, physical activity, nutrition, sexual behavior, and emotional

health in grades 7, 9, and 11. The 2018 data report will be reviewed to shed light on the outcomes of the 2018 survey.
